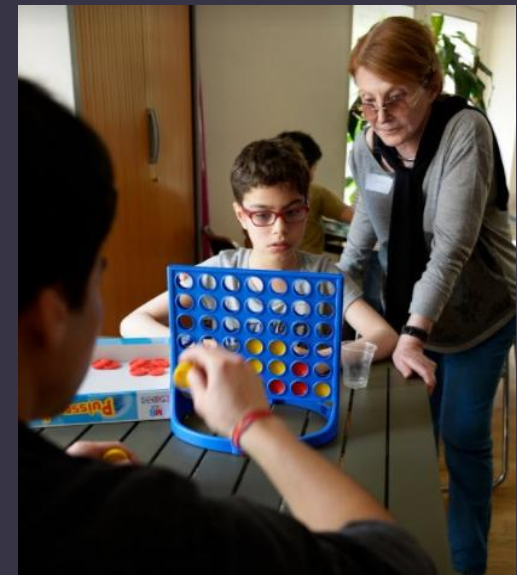
These activities aim to:

The activities proposed by E-Juniors (1)

- The association has established a quality partnership with the town hall of the 4th arrondissement of Paris and regularly offers intergenerational activities where juniors and seniors meet at workshops, games or digital treasure hunts.



The activities proposed by E-Juniors (2)

Within the framework of European projects (Europe for Citizens, Youth in Action and Erasmus+ KA1 & KA2), E-Juniors offers various workshops on different subjects such as:

- European citizenship
- Social entrepreneurship
- Youth mediation
- Exchange of skills
- Etc.



Our European projects

- PUnCH (Europe for Citizens) aims at giving disadvantaged young citizens and underrepresented groups the opportunity to intervene in the debate on the Future of Europe in general and the EU policies about the valorization of the Cultural Heritage in particular.



- HYPER (Erasmus+, KA2) fights against radicalization of younger people by developing specific online curricula specifically tailored on young people needs.



- EuthWork (Erasmus+) is a KA1 project designing and implementing a training for youth workers. The project relies on expert youth educators providing 2 specific trainings (in France and in La Réunion) to more than 30 young learners.



- IDEA-C (Europe for Citizens) aims at promoting active citizenship among young people and in particular at encouraging participation in democratic participation in Europe.



- Simplifier (Erasmus+) trains youngsters to become educators by offering them 2 trainings to learn soft and hard skills.
