




4. Ideas collection

Group 1

"Restoration summer school"

Bring together youth, students specialized in landscape, cultural heritage, history, visual arts, garden heritage and experts in CH and historical gardens to do research and design restoration and management strategies for the heritage estate.

Group 2

"Street Debate- Your Heritage, Your Future"

Organize a street debate where the citizens have shared their issues/solutions/ideas/story regarding the local heritage so in this way authorities could implement the idea or solve the problems.



"Teaching you"

Citizens with disabilities could organize with the help of local authorities handcraft workshops or exhibitions (free to the public) in buildings or spaces that have a history.

Students from architecture, history, literature, tourism can do their university practice as free tour guides.
